Edithvale Road/Branagan Drive, Aspendale Gardens - Pedestrian Upgrades

We plan to construct new pram crossings and path connections at the intersection of Edithvale Road and Branagan Drive to improve safety and amenity for pedestrians and the community.

The improvements will include:

- Construction of DDA compliant pram crossings at the corner of Edithvale Road and Branagan Drive.
- New path connections to connect the crossings.
- Reconstruction of the central traffic island to incorporate a pedestrian refuge.

Significant trees will be retained, and tree protection measures will be in place during the works.



Construction Details

The project is expected to occur in 2025 and will take around 4-6 weeks to complete. More specific information regarding timing will be available when a contractor is appointed by Council.

During the construction works some temporary restrictions to pedestrian areas will be put in place. We will aim to minimise disruptions and will provide signage to let you know if there are alternative pathways/any detours in place.

Additional information will be provided closer to the time of construction, including who to contact during construction if you have any questions.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
