Due to growing local demand, Council is planning to undertake improvements to Leslie Road, Clarinda. These improvements will include:

- upgrading the existing gravel road with a new crushed rock surface
- providing parking and vehicle passing areas.

Works are scheduled to commence in late 2024 and will take around 8 weeks to complete.

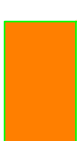
CRUSHED ROCK ROAD - 5m WIDE
