## Main Street, Mordialloc, Installation of Gross Pollutant Traps

Every year we invest millions in Kingston's roads, footpath, and drainage network, to support the current and future needs of our community – which includes protecting the health of our waterways.

We plan to install two Gross Pollutant Traps (GPTs) on both sides of Main Street, Mordialloc, in front of Mordy Surf (231-232); and the Velas Apartments (555).

GPTs are highly effective at safeguarding our waterways, as they stop large debris and pollutants from entering stormwater – which flows into Port Phillip Bay.

These units will have the combined capacity of capturing around 14 cubic meters of litter (which would fill an average sized bathroom to the ceiling).. Putting these GPTs in place will be an important step towards protecting our environment.

#### **Construction Details**

Works are expected to commence between March and June 2024 and will take around 12 weeks to complete. The exact commencement date will be determined once the construction contract has been awarded.

During construction works some car spaces will be unavailable. We will aim to minimise disruption as much as possible. Please refer to the attached site plan for more information.

Closer to the time of construction, additional information will be provided, with details on who to contact during construction.

We look forward to delivering these improvements for the community.
