Mills Road, Braeside – Industrial Footpath Construction (stage 2)

Following the completion of the initial work in June 2023, stage 2 of the industrial footpath construction along Mills Road in Braeside is set to begin in mid-2025.

This stage of works will include:

- A new footpath being built on the northern side of Mills Road from Boundary Road to Downard Road, as well as along the southern side between the Melbourne Water culvert (stormwater drain) and Woodlands Drive.
- The installation of pram crossings and pedestrian islands at the Woodlands Drive / Mills Road roundabout to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity.
- A section of footpath in front of 5-15 Mills Road being constructed with a permeable pavement - allowing trees to be retained and remain healthy.

Construction Details

Works will commence in mid-2025 and are estimated to take 6-8 weeks to complete, weather permitting. The construction may restrict access to some pedestrian areas for short periods of time.

We aim to minimise disruption and will provide adequate signage for alternative pathways.

Additional information will be provided closer to the commencement of the works, including details on who to contact during construction.








PROPOSED GRANITIC
