An update on the playground at Meribah Court Reserve, Parkdale

We're excited to move ahead with our plans to upgrade the Meribah Court Reserve playspace in Parkdale! We're writing to advise nearby residents that construction is due to commence in early March.

The new playground area has been designed to offer an inclusive experience and play environment for all (please see design overleaf).

Highlights of the design include:

- New shelter and picnic area
- Nature Play
- · Climbing net
- · Pyramid net and junior rocker
- Tri-swing set with basket swing
- Combination unit suitable for junior and senior children
- New park furniture and drinking fountain
- · Aeroplane stencil artwork

Additional trees and landscaping improvements are included in the design to provide natural shade and screening.

Project timing and impacts

Construction works are due to commence in early March. We anticipate the works will be complete by the end of June 2025, weather permitting.

Access to parts of the Meribah Court Reserve will be restricted throughout the works, with temporary fencing installed for the safety of the community.

We apologise for any inconvenience and will minimise disruption wherever possible while maintaining a safe work site.
