

KINGSTON'S PET EXPO DOG TRICK COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The name of the competition is "Kingston's Pet Expo Dog Trick Competition".
- 2. The Promoter of the Competition is City of Kingston (ABN 80 640 377 247) of 1230 Nepean Hwy, Cheltenham VIC 3192 ("the Promoter").
- 3. By submitting you and your dog into the 'Dog Trick' Competition, guardians are signifying that they have read and agreed to these terms and conditions and entrants have consent of their guardian to enter.
- 4. The Competition will commence at 12.00pm Saturday 29 March 2025 and close 12.15pm on Saturday 29 March 2025 ("the Competition Period").
- 5. To enter the Competition, entrants must register at the Kingston registration marquee at the Expo on Saturday 29 March from 9.00am until 11.45am and collect a competition voucher. Entries will be called to the main stage at the competition time to demonstrate their 'best dog trick' in front of the judges.
- 6. This is a competition of skill and will be individually judged by representatives of the Promoter on the basis of originality and creativity.
- 7. The Promoter will be selecting one (1) winner on Saturday 29 March at the Expo. The most original and creative entry as judged by the Promoter will receive an applicable prize.
- 8. Prize is not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash. Prize must be taken as described and no compensation will be payable if the winner is unable to use the prize as described.
- 9. Once prizes have left the Promoter's or its agent's premises, no responsibility is accepted for prizes damaged, delayed or lost in transit and after they are released to the winners.
- 10. Any costs associated with entering the Competition are the responsibility of the entrant.
- 18. Contact information provided by the entrant is to be retained only for the purposes of awarding prizes and acknowledging entrants. By entering the competition, the entrant gives the Promoter license to use their entry for promotional purposes including publication online and print media.
