Edithvale Shopping Strip Revitalisation – Project Update

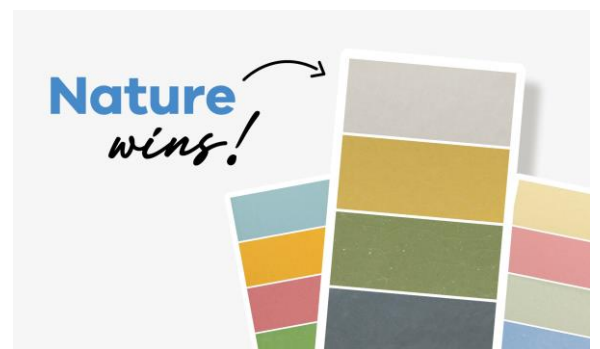
The Edithvale Shopping Strip Revitalisation project is progressing well, with the project expected to be tendered before the end of 2024. Works are expected to commence in mid-2025.

Background

We asked for your feedback on the preferred colour palette for the street furniture (seating) and are excited to announce the clear winner from the community was 'Nature'.

We also asked for your feedback on design elements of the plans. We carefully considered all your suggestions and thanks to your input, the revised designs now include:

- More bicycle racks
- An accessible parking bay
- Redesign of the climbing planters to complement the 'nature-themed' brick seating
- Consideration towards using sustainable building materials
- Timber slats within the glazed brick seating modules
- More greenery and trees for shade with the consideration towards selecting native plants.
