

Attracting lizards and skinks to your garden

Blue-tongued Lizards, Marbled Geckos and Garden Skinks generally prefer to snack on insects, but are opportunists that will also eat berries and seed.

Habitat tips:

- plant clumps of native grasses to provide protection
- provide flat rocks in a sunny spot to warm up
- mulch garden beds to attract insects to eat
- practice natural pest control
- include a shallow water supply on the ground that includes rocks or sticks for safe access
- keep cats contained 24/7.
